Key Terms:

Campaign: Focused fundraising initiative conducted annually from Sept.- Feb. during which UW staff and volunteers work together to raise funds aimed at reaching an overall income goal, funds are then allocated to partner agencies to support various community initiatives.

CAT: Campaign Advancement Team, group of volunteers focused on fundraising and relationship building efforts in 5 areas, University of Iowa, Leadership Donors, Washington County, Prospective Donors, and Campaign Events.

ECC: Employee Campaign Coordinator, a champion of United Way at a local business who helps create giving opportunities for workplace to have a successful campaign.

Pace Report: Campaign tracking report comparing year to date, last year amounts, and goal amounts for top tier companies and additional campaign events.
