#### **Mosaic Iowa City (formerly Ten Thousand Villages) MOSaic** 9th Annual Rug Event Fundraiser October 1-5 Hyatt Regency Hotel Coralville Iowa River Landing

Mosaic partners with fair trade job creation program Bunyaad to bring ethically made, hand knotted rugs made by fairly paid artisans in rural Pakistan to Iowa City for sale. 50% of proceeds go right back to artisans (they have already been paid for the rugs) and this allows them to prepare the supplies for next year's rugs. 25% of proceeds go to Mosaic as a fundraiser for our local nonprofit and 25% goes to nonprofit Bunyaad to finance the touring of the rugs around the country.

Volunteers are needed help flip rugs to show to customers for two hour shifts each day: 10am-12pm, 12pm-2pm, 2pm-4pm, 4pm-6pm, or 5pm-7pm

10 volunteers are needed to help tear-down the event on Sunday, October 5 from 5pm-7pm/8pm. Volunteers will roll up rugs and carry them to the truck for loading. Tear-down volunteers should be able to lift over 30 lbs.
